SPORTSMANSHIP AND PERSONAL CONDUCT

The Lyndhurst Dads' Club sets the highest standards for Sportsmanship and Personal Conduct and requires that all Managers, Coaches, Players and Spectators adhere to those standards, at all times, during the course of the Tournament.

While recognizing that tournament play is on a more competitive level than the recreational programs within their home communities/organizations; all participants must realize that tournament play is still about our kids. It is not, ultimately, about who wins or loses, the size of the trophy you may be awarded or "bragging" rights. It's about providing an enjoyable, exciting, challenging and learning experience for the players.

Each of us is personally responsible for our own conduct. Additionally, as Managers, Coaches, Tournament Officials, Spectators and adults it is our responsibility to ensure that a safe, positive and sportsmanlike environment is afforded the participants by everyone participating in the tournament.

The use of abusive or offensive language, unsportsmanlike conduct, or displaying a lack of respect for umpires or others is unacceptable under any circumstances, by anyone.

The Lyndhurst Dads' Club reserves the right to disqualify any individual from further participation in a game, or the Tournament itself, for offensive conduct and/or unsportsmanlike actions.
